

Agreement to Participate In the Central Intermediate Unit # 10 Online Learning Association (CIOLA) Between the Central Intermediate Unit # 10 and the State College Area School District

This Agreement to participate in CIOLA (hereinafter "Agreement") is made this December 3, 2018, by and between the Central Intermediate Unit # 10 (hereinafter "CIU # 10"), a public, not-for-profit, regional education service agency established under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with its principal place of business at 345 Link Road, West Decatur, PA 16833, and the State College Area School District (hereinafter "District"), a school district with its principal place of business at 240 Villa Crest Drive, State College, PA . 16801.

1 Scope of Work.

1.1 CIU # 10 agrees to perform services as follows:

- Offer guidance and best practices with the development and management of online program.
- Assist with back office administration including invoice production, enrollment tracking and pupil attendance.
- Assistance with development of district policies and procedures.
- Provide customized marketing and public relations support including parent information events, ads in magazines and assistance with recruiting full time cyber students back to district.
- Assist with the development of new courses or acquiring new vendors to support district needs.
- Develop and coordinate an individualized professional development program for administrative, support and professional staff.
- Regional networking for collaboration within the CIOLA community.
- CIOLA support provides technical support for students and district personnel.

2 Responsibilities of the Parties.

2.1 Both parties agree to act in good faith in fulfillment of this Agreement. Neither party shall attempt to hinder or otherwise prevent the other party from fulfilling their duties as outline herein.

2.2 The CIU # 10 will provide the District access to a full featured web based online learning system with services, benefits and courses as detailed in the CIOLA Pricing Guide included as Attachment A to the Agreement.

2.3 District shall:

- Provide personnel for the following positions:
 - Site coordinator.
 - Technology coordinator.
 - Student mentor.
- Ensure that district's technology meets CIOLA's requirements.
- Identify and attend system training.
- Participate in monthly networking meetings.

3 Cost. In consideration for the work to be provided under this Agreement, District agrees to pay and CIU # 10 agrees to accept, a prorated amount of \$7,500 in fulfillment of this Agreement for the 2018-2019 fiscal year. Additional cost terms, if any, shall be addressed in paragraph 8 herein or subsequent Addenda as agreed to by both parties.

3.1 Member costs for courses are detailed in the CIOLA Pricing Guide included as Attachment A to the Agreement and are subject to change. Costs for services and courses not identified in the Pricing Guide will be as negotiated.

4 Invoicing and Payment. Additional invoicing and payment terms, if any, shall be addressed in Attachment 1 or subsequent Addenda as agreed to by both parties. If the District accepts private payments for services, the district is responsible for processing these payments and submitting one check for payment to the CIU # 10. The CIU # 10 will not accept payments made payable to the district or parent payments made payable to the CIU # 10.

5 Term and Renewal.

5.1 The term of this Agreement shall be January 1, 2019 to June 30, 2019.

5.2 This contract does not supplant any existing services provided by the CIU # 10 to State College Area School District.

7.2 Any changes, additions, or deletions to the Scope of Work shall be considered a modification as described herein. Any such modification must be subsequently labeled, *Addendum 1*, *Addendum 2*, *en sic*. To be valid, any modifications/amendments to this Agreement shall be made in writing, signed by an authorized representative of both parties, and dated.

7.3 It is specifically understood and agreed that every Addendum must be separately negotiated and a revised price agreed upon in writing by both parties.

By signing below, each person represents he/she has the authority to execute this Agreement on behalf of his/her respective party and freely enters into this Agreement with the intent to be bound hereby as of the date set forth above.
