The Central Intermediate Unit #10 is proud to announce the CIU # 10 E.D.U.C.A.T.E. Fund. This program has been created and funded by CIU # 10 employees. Participating employees have a monetary deduction taken from his or her monthly paycheck and it is donated to the E.D.U.C.A.T.E. Fund. *The goal of the E.D.U.C.A.T.E. Program is to provide a monetary award directly to schools in Centre, Clearfield, and Clinton Counties. The allocation is to be used for student projects or programs that require funds to meet the project goal(s).*

FUNDING: The E.D.U.C.A.T.E. Funds will be awarded biannually with a maximum award up to \$1,000. This could be one project of up to \$1,000 or several classroom projects from multiple schools totaling \$1,000. E.D.U.C.A.T.E. Funds cannot be utilized for salary, benefits, advertising, mileage reimbursement, awards, food or parties. The funds are to be used exclusively for project supplies, equipment, technology, and/or software that cannot be purchased with the district funds.

HOW TO APPLY: Applications are accepted and reviewed bi-annually. Interested applicants should complete the CIU # 10 E.D.U.C.A.T.E. Fund Application online. The completed application should be sent to Haylee Hickman, hhickman@ciu10.org upon completion.

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS: Applications can only be submitted by administrators or teachers of CIU # 10 member schools. Collaborative project submissions are encouraged. Each application will be reviewed based on the following criteria:

1. Detailed description of the proposed project
2. Itemized budget for the use of allocated funds
3. Overall impact on students, school building, and/or community
4. Project goals are clearly defined and measurable

Final award is contingent upon the approval of the executive officer of the member school.
