

Pennsylvania LGBTQ+ History Prize

The Army Heritage Center Foundation, the LGBT Center of Central PA History Project, and the PA LGBT History Network are pleased to announce the inauguration of the Pennsylvania LGBTQ+ History Prize.

This award, sponsored by the LGBT Center of Central PA History Project and the PA LGBT History Network, will recognize an outstanding entry in any category, in either division, that involves an aspect of LGBTQ+ history that is entered in the National History Day in Pennsylvania State Contest. Student projects must clearly reflect the theme of History Day and demonstrate balanced research and a clear understanding of the topic and its place in history. The use of non-traditional research sources (such as oral histories, photos, newspaper clippings, etc.) is acceptable because LGBTQ+ history is often not recorded in traditional formats.
