CIU 10 to Build New Offices in Philipsburg

Over the past several years, CIU 10 Board of Directors and Administrative Team have worked to secure a new location for the administrative offices. On April 17, 2023, CIU 10 was the successful bidder for property located at 100 North Sixth Street in Philipsburg Borough. The property is the former site of the Philipsburg Junior High School on which a gymnasium building remains. The building will be transformed into a two story facility which will house both office and training space. Approximately 50 employees of CIU 10 will be based at this location and it will also offer the opportunity to host training conducted by CIU 10 staff as well as our partners at the state level. The Philipsburg location provides a central spot for our three county region. CIU 10 is thrilled to continue to provide educational services at a site that was once a school. The timeline for completion of the project is 18 months with the hope of taking occupancy in the fall of 2024.

Legislative Roundtable: March 17, 2023

CIU 10 hosted the second annual Legislative Roundtable event on March 17, 2023. Members of the General Assembly that represent Centre, Clearfield and Clinton counties were invited along with Superintendents, District Board Members and CIU 10 Board Members. The discussion surrounded topics of teacher staffing shortages, cyber charter reform, and CTC and workforce development connections. The dialogue between educational leaders, board members and elected officials of the general assembly is critical as we all continue to address the needs and challenges currently facing public education.

She graduated with her GED after 9 months of studying, testing, feeling discouraged, receiving gentle pushes, and showing everyone she was persistent - not letting anything get in her way.

Brooke has an amazing support system, as illustrated by her family joining her for graduation photos. But her perseverance and belief in herself is what pushed her over the finish line.

2023 PA Media & Design Competition

The PA Media and Design Competition is an annual event that highlights Pennsylvania students' application skills, creativity and knowledge.

Participants at this year's competition attended from Clearfield County Career and Technical Center, MoValley Area School District, and Bald Eagle Area School District.



Each spring, the CIU 10 hosts a **Reading Competition** for elementary school students.

Teams consist of 6 to 12 students from 4th to 6th grade, and they work together to read the books on the official competition book list.



Destination Imagination (DI) is an international problem-solving competition available in Pennsylvania for students of all ages.



The 24 Challenge® is a tournament-style competition organized around the 24® Game. Offered in a tournament-style competition, students compete using addition, subtraction, multiplication, or division to develop solutions to problems that equal 24



Each year, teams are given the "STEM Design Challenge" to find a solution to an engineering problem. Students work in small teams to design and build projects from a K'Nex Challenge set.



National History Day, a non-profit education organization, offers year-long academic programs that engage over half a million middle- and high school students around the world annually in conducting and presenting original research on historical topics.
